CRITERIA OF THIRD ADMISSION LIST FOR GENERAL & OBC CATEGORIES

B.Com (Prog)

General Category closed

Only for OBC Category :

CATEGORY-I

78.5% and above marks in aggregate of Commerce stream i.e. Hindi/English and any three of Business Studies, Accounts, Economics & Mathematics.

CATEGORY-II

81.5% and above marks in aggregate of Commerce stream (one vocational subject relating to Commerce would be considered).

CATEGORY-III

82.5% marks and above in aggregate for Science & Arts stream.

Note : In all the above categories Mathematics must have been studied upto 10th standard.

B.Com (Hons.)

General Category closed

Only for OBC Category :

CATEGORY-I

82.5% and above marks in aggregate with all the 04 academic subjects (including language) i.e. Maths, Accounts, Economics, Business Studies, Commerce & English/Hindi language.

CATEGORY-II

83.5% and above marks in aggregate with 03 academic and one vocational subject. Vocational subject relating to Commerce will be considered provided candidate has combination of Accounts and Mathematics.

CATEGORY-III

84.5% marks and above in aggregate for Science stream i.e. Hindi/English and any three of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Economics & Mathematics.

Note : In all the above categories Mathematics must have been studied at +2 level.

B.A.(Prog.) with "Advertising Sales Promotion & Sales Management"

Only for OBC Category :

72% and above marks in aggregate with all the 04 academic subjects in Commerce/Science/Arts stream i.e. Hindi/English and any three pure academic subjects related to the respective discipline.

CATEGORY-II

75% and above marks in aggregate with 03 academic and one vocational subject in Commerce/Science/ Arts stream

B.A.(Hons) Political Science **General Category closed**

Only for OBC Category :

CATEGORY-I

66% and above marks in aggregate with all the 04 academic subjects in Humanities and 72% marks in Pol.Science.

CATEGORY-II

73% and above marks in aggregate and atleast 72% marks in Pol.Science. The aggregate marks are for 03 academic subjects of Humanities stream and one vocational subject.

CATEGORY-III

73% and above marks in aggregate in Science/Commerce stream without Pol.Science.

Note : The aggregate marks indicate one language and three other subjects, i.e. best of four.

B.A.(Hons)Philosophy

CATEGORY-I

75% and above marks in aggregate with best four academic subjects & 72% and above marks in English.

For O.B.C. candidates, 7% relaxation will be given.

B.A.(Hons) Economics **General Category closed**

Only for OBC Category :

CATEGORY-I

83.25% and above marks in 04 academic subjects with 1 language and any 03 subject from Commerce & Humanities stream. Minimum 75% in Mathematics is compulsory.

CATEGORY-II

81.25% and above marks in 04 academic subjects with 1 language and any 03 subject from Science stream. Minimum 75% in Mathematics is compulsory.

CATEGORY-III

87% and above marks in 04 academic subjects with 1 language and any 2 academic subject and any 01 of the following subjects : Physical Education, Fine Art, Dance & Music.

B.A.(Hons)Psychology

CATEGORY-I

89% and above marks in aggregate (best of 04 subjects) with one language and any 03 of the following subjects : Economics, Pol. Science, History, Geography, Sociology, Philosophy, Mathematics & Psychology.

CATEGORY-II

91% and above marks in aggregate (with best of 04 subjects) with one language and any three subjects from Science or Commerce stream.

CATEGORY-III

95% and above marks in aggregate with one language and 02 academic subjects and any one of the following subjects : Home Science, Fine Arts, Agriculture, Computer Science, Informatics Practice, Physical Education, Music, Dance, Entrepreneurship.

For O.B.C. candidates, 10% relaxation for all the above three categories.

Note : 01% concession in aggregate for students with minimum 80% marks in Psychology.

B.A.(Hons) Sociology

81% and above marks in aggregate with 03 subjects out of the following :-

Sociology, Anthropology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Mathematics, Psychology, Philosophy, Hindi Elective & English Elective.

PLUS

70% and above marks in English.

Note : 05% concession in aggregate will be given to students who have secured 76% and above marks in Sociology in Class-XII examination.

CATEGORY-II

85% and above marks in aggregate with :

02 subjects out of the following :- Sociology, Anthropology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Mathematics, Psychology, Philosophy, Hindi Elective & English Elective..

PLUS

Any one subject of the following :

Home Science, Fine Arts, Computer Science, Informative Practices, Physical Education, Web and Multimedia Technology, Music, Dance, Commerce, Entrepreneurships, Accountancy, Fashion Studies & Business Studies.

PLUS

70% and above marks in English.

Note : 05% concession in aggregate will be given to students who have secured 76% and above marks in Sociology in Class-XII examination.

CATEGORY-III

87.5% and above marks with

03 subjects out of the following :- Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Engineering Drawing, Economics, Office Secretaryship, Accounting and Auditing, Banking, Accountancy, Commerce, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Entrepreneurship, Bio-Technology, Business Studies, & Web and Multimedia technology & Physical Education.

70% and above marks in English.

Note : 05% concession in aggregate will be given to students who have secured 76% and above marks in Sociology in Class-XII examination.

For O.B.C. candidates, 7% relaxation for all the above three categories.

B.A.(Hons) Mathematics

General Category closed

Only for OBC Category :

72% and above marks in best of 04 academic subjects including English and 83% marks in Mathematics.

Note : No Vocational subject would be included in the best of four subjects. Only Computer Science can be included in best of 04 academic subjects.

**B.A.(Hons.) Geography
General Category closed**

Only for OBC Category :

CATEGORY-I (For Humanities)

69% and above marks in best of four subjects (one language, two academic and one vocational subject) & 75% and above marks in Geography.

CATEGORY-II (For Science/Commerce)

71% and above marks in best of four subjects i.e. one language, two academic and one vocational subject for candidates without Geography.

**B.A.(Hons) History
General Category closed**

Only for OBC Category :

CATEGORY-I:

61.5% and above marks in Humanities (04 academic subjects) with atleast 60% marks in English.

CATEGORY-II

62.5% and above marks in Science stream and atleast 60% marks in English.

CATEGORY-III

69.5% and above marks in Commerce stream and atleast 65% marks in English.

CATEGORY-IV

75% and above marks in aggregate with 03 academic subjects and one vocational subjects with atleast 80% in English.

**B.A.(Hons.) Hindi
General Category closed**

Only for OBC Category :

54% and above marks in aggregate with all the 03 academic and 01 vocational subjects and atleast 67% & above marks in Elective Hindi or 69% & above marks in Core Hindi at +2 level.

Note : English/Sanskrit is a compulsory subject in Class-XII.

45% and above marks in best of four subjects in Humanities stream and knowledge of Sanskrit is compulsory.

CATEGORY-II

50% and above marks in best of four subjects for Commerce/Science stream and knowledge of Sanskrit is compulsory.

45% and above marks in best of four subjects in Humanities stream and knowledge of Sanskrit is compulsory.

48% and above marks in best of four subjects for Commerce/Science stream and knowledge of Sanskrit is compulsory.
