B.Com (Hons)	Best Four Subjects (including one language)	Minimum 60% aggregate and Maths Compulsory at 10+2 level. 5% marks shall be deducted for Non Commerce streams. Home Science, Fine Arts, Agriculture, Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy, Physical Edu., Music, Dance and Biotechnology will not be considered for admission. Maximum one vocational subjects out of Office Secretaryship, Stenography (English), Accounting & Auditing, Marketing & Salesmanship, Purchasing & Store keeping and Banking shall be considered.
B.A. (H) Political Sc.	For Humanities stream : Pol. Sc., English and any other two best Subjects. For Science & Commerce stream: (Best Four Subjects)	5% marks shall be deducted for Science & Commerce students.
B.A. (H) Hindi	Best Four Subjects	Hindi shall be compulsory at 10+2 level. All academic subjects shall be considered for admission. No deduction of marks for science and commerce students.
B.A. (Programme)	Best Four Subjects (including one language)	Not more than one out of the following subjects be considered: Home Science, Fine Arts, Agriculture, Physical Edu, Music and Dance. Vocational Subjects to be considered are Office Secretaryship, Stenography and Computer. No deduction of marks for science and commerce students.
B.Sc. (H) Electronics	Aggregate marks of Physics, Chemistry and Maths	Minimum 55% in Physics, Chemistry and Maths. Students should have 50% marks in English in 10+2.
B.Sc. Program Appl. Phy. Sc.	PM + Computer Science / Chemistry / Biology / IP	Aggregate marks of 3 subjects 1. Maths 2. Physics 3. Anyone from Computer Science/Biology/ Chemistry/Info. Practice.
B.Sc. (Gen) Math. Sc.	Best Four Subjects (including one language)	One language and mathematics shall be the compulsory subjects and 2 subjects from following list shall be considered 1. Physics 2. Chemistry 3. Biology 4. Computer Sc. 5. Info. Practice 6. Economics 7. Accountancy 8. Engg. Drawing 9. Business Studies 10. I.T. Systems
