ADMISSION POLICY FOR THE YEAR 2011-2012

- Marks in physical Education, Home Science, Painting, Commercial Art, Sanskrit, Agriculture etc. shall not be considered as part of the aggregate until and unless specifically permitted to be included for a particular course.
- Students of any stream with mathematics in Class XII can apply for admission to 1st year of B.Sc. (Hons.) Maths, Statistics and Computer Science, provided they are otherwise eligible.

B.A. (Programme)

Aggregate marks of English / Hindi and three other subjects. Mathematics combination will be offered to those who have studied Mathematics upto +2 level.

B.Com.

Students from commerce stream:

The students must have studied English/ Hindi & Accountancy. For determining eligibility, marks in English/Hindi and three other subjects out of Economics, Business Studies, Mathematics, Accountancy, Management and Insurance (Academic Stream), as per C.B.S.E Scheme of examination shall be taken into account. A handicap of 3% will be taken into account if they have not studied Maths at 10+2 Level.

Students from non – Commerce Stream:

For determining their eligibility, marks in English/Hindi plus three other subjects from the specified list other than languages shall be taken into account with a handicap of 3% in aggregate if they have maths at 10+2 level & a handicap of 5% if they do not have the maths at 10+2 level, over the cut off marks for students of commerce stream will be applied.

B.Com. (Hons.)

Students form Commerce stream:

The student must have studied English and Accountancy. For determining eligibility, marks in English or Hindi and three subjects, out of the following: Economics, Business Studies, Mathematics, Accountancy, Management and Insurance (Academic Stream), as per C.B.S.E. Scheme of examination shall be taken into account. A Handicap of 3% will be taken into account if they have not studied Maths at 10+2 Level.

Students from non-Commerce Stream:

For determining their eligibility, marks in English/ Hindi and three subjects from the specified list, other than languages shall be taken into account. A handicap of 3% in aggregate if they have maths at 10+2 level & a handicap of 5% if they do not have the maths at 10+2 level, over the cut off marks for students from commerce stream will be applied.

NOTE: For B.Com. & B.Com (H) papers with 70% or above weightage in marks in practical will not be counted in best four subjects.

B.A. (Hons.) Economics

Aggregate of four subjects including English will be considered for admission. In addition the candidate must have studied Mathematics and secured at least 60% marks in Mathematics at 10+2 level.

B.A (Hons.) English

Candidates seeking admission to this course require an aggregate of four subjects with 60% marks in Elective English and 75% marks in Core / Functional English.

A Maximum of two languages will be considered for determining admission eligibility.

Vocational Stream subjects (please refer to the university list) will not be considered. Academic Stream subjects which will NOT be considered are Engineering Drawing, Fine Arts, Agriculture, Physical Education, Music, Dance & Fashion Study. However Home Science will be considered to determine the eligibility.

B.A. (Hons.) Hindi

Aggregate of four subjects with 50% marks in Elective Hindi or 55% marks in core Hindi, If a Student has 65% and above marks in Hindi, Marks in Physical education, Music and Home Science may also be considered to determine the eligibility, provided their theory portion is not less than 70%.

B.A.(Hons.) History

No subject from vocational stream will be considered.

The aggregate marks of one language English/ Hindi / Sanskrit and three best elective subjects, one of which may be elective language, will be considered.

The following subjects from academic stream will be considered.

Mathematics, Physics, chemistry, Business Studies, Accountancy, Biology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy, Home Science, Computer Science and Information Practices.

B.A.(Hons.) Pol. Science

The aggregate marks of one language English/ Hindi / Sanskrit and three best elective subjects, one of which may be elective language, will be considered.

Subjects from vocational stream will not be considered.

The following subjects from academic stream will be considered:

Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Business Studies, Accountancy, Biology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy, Home Science, Computer Science, Information Practices and Physical Education.

B.A. (Hons.) Sanskrit

Aggregate of four subjects including 45% marks in Sanskrit at 10+2 or 50% marks in Sanskrit in class X examination. (if the candidate has not studied Sanskrit at 10+2 level).

B.Sc.(Hons.) Mathematics

A student must have qualified in English at class XII. Aggregate of four subjects including a language, Mathematics with at least 75% of marks in maths and two subjects out of the following:

Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, Bio-technology, Geology, Business Studies, Accountancy, Economics, Geography, History & Political Science.

B.Sc. (Hons.) Statistics

Aggregate of four subjects (including Mathematics, English and two subjects out of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Engineering Drawing, Economics, Business Studies, Accountancy, Computer Science, Bio-technology, Geology, History, Political Science and Geography).

B.Sc.(Hons.) Computer Science

Minimum eligibility for admission is at least 60% marks in Mathematics. Admission would be based on aggregate marks scored (at class XII) in the best three subjects including Mathematics and two academic subject (including not more than one

language). An advantage of 5% will be given to the students (in calculation of best three) who have studied physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at class XII.

B.Sc. (Gen.) Mathematical Sciences

Aggregate of Mathematics, English and two academic subjects other than languages with at least 60% marks in mathematics. An advantage of 5% in the aggregate (of four subjects) will be given to candidates with computer Science (only when computer science is considered in calculation of best four). **Subjects like Informatics Practices, web and Multimedia technology shall not be considered in lieu of computer Science.**

The following subjects from academic stream will be considered for admission to B.Sc. (H) Computer Science and B.Sc. (G) Mathematical Science.

Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Economics, Business Studies, Accountancy, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Web and Multimedia Technology and English.

Admission under Sports & ECA category:

These admissions will be as per University Guidelines.
