Information regarding the additional eligibility criteria such as additional subject requirement and percentage deduction/relaxation in the various courses for admission in the 1st year class to be compiled and published in the University Information Bulletin 2011-12.

1. Urdu (H)

Must have obtained 40% marks in Urdu in class XIIth.

2. Sanskrit (H)

Must have studied Sanskrit in class Xth and obtained pass marks in Sanskrit.

3. Political Science (H)

5% higher eligibility in aggregate marks for students without Political Science

4. History (H)

(i) Minimum 50% in History  
(ii) 5% higher eligibility in aggregate marks for students without History.

5. Bengali (Discipline)

Must have passed Bengali either in class Xth or in class XIIth

6. Urdu (Discipline)

Must have obtained 40% marks in Urdu in class XIIth.

Relaxation for Urdu/Bengali

A relaxation between 5% and 10% marks will be given to students who studied Urdu/Bengali and opting these subjects for all courses such as B.A. (H), B.Com (H), B.Com (Prog.) and B.A. (Prog.).

7. English (Discipline)

A special eligibility criteria (marks in English and the aggregate should not be below 50%) is needed for English Discipline because the requirements for this course entail a certain level of comprehension of literatures, almost bordering upon the English (H) course.

Rationale

Honours courses are sophisticated and specialized courses and hence prior factual knowledge of the concerned subject is therefore essential.
