

Eligibility Criteria for Admission to the B.El.Ed. Course of the University of Delhi

1. Eligibility/Qualifications Required:

(A) Candidates seeking admission to the Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) programme must have passed the Class XII examination of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) or any other Board recognized as equivalent to the CBSE with at least 55% marks in the aggregate and 50% marks in each of the following four subjects:

(i) One from List A and three from List B

OR

(ii) One from List A, two from List B and one from List C

Note : *Not more than two languages will be considered for the purpose of eligibility from List A and List B together.

(B) Candidate should have completed 17 years of age on or before July 13, 2011.

प्रवेश-योग्यता

1. प्रवेश के केन्द्रीय उच्चतर माध्यमिक बोर्ड अथवा किसी भी मान्यता प्राप्त बोर्ड से बारहवीं कक्षा में एक भाषा और वैकल्पिक विषयों सहित न्यूनतम 55 प्रतिशत अंक अनिवार्य है।
2. दसवीं कक्षा तक एक विषय के रूप में हिन्दी का अध्ययन अनिवार्य है।
3. योग्य अभ्यर्थियों को लिखित प्रवेश-परीक्षा (60 प्रतिशत) 12वीं कक्षा के परीक्षा परिणाम (30 प्रतिशत) और साक्षात्कार (10 प्रतिशत) के आधार पर प्रवेश दिया जाएगा।

Eligibility Criteria for B.A.(Hons) Social Work

Eligibility

1. The candidates should have 45% or equivalent grade in Class XII (Unreserved Category) and 40% marks or equivalent grade in Class XII (For Reserved Category).
2. The candidates should have to clear / qualify Entrance Test consisting of Written Test and Panel Interview.

The admission is based on : (Weightage)

- a) 40% for performance in Class XII or equivalent grade
- b) 50% for written test
- c) 10% for Panel Interview

Date of Written Test : 23rd June, 2011

Date of Interview : 24th June, 2011

The Written Test and Panel Interview are compulsory.

The Written Test seeks to ensure that a candidate has at least a working knowledge of English and Hindi, general awareness of social issues and her aptitude for professional Social Work. Entrance Test fee will be Rs.150/- (fee may be revised).

Any changes would be as per University norms.

Eligibility Criteria for B.A. (Hons.) Geography

1. An aggregate of 45% marks in the qualifying examination.
2. Preference would be given to the candidate who has studied Geography in Class XII. The merit shall be determined on the basis of one language and three best elective subjects.

Eligibility Criteria for B.A. Programme Discipline Courses

1. For Mathematics discipline course, applicants should have / had Mathematics as an elective subject in Class XII.
2. For Psychology discipline, minimum of 60% marks in class XII are required and preference shall be given to Science or Commerce students.
3. For Music discipline, practical test is conducted at the time of admission.
4. For Economics discipline, applicants with science opting for economics should have mathematics as an elective subject in class XII.
5. For Political Science discipline, applicants should have a minimum of 50% marks in class XII and preference shall be given to those with Political Science as an elective subject.
6. For Family and Child Welfare discipline, preference shall be given to applicants with Home Science subject in Class XII.
7. For Food Technology discipline, preference shall be given to applicants with Home Science and English subjects in Class XII.
8. For Nutrition and Health Education discipline, preference shall be given to applicants with Home Science subject in Class XII.
9. For Office Management and Secretarial Practice discipline, having English subject at 10+2 level is compulsory. Preference would be given to students having Office Management and Stenography at 10+2 level and a basic working knowledge of computers.

Eligibility Criteria for B.Com.

Eligibility

1. Candidates should have obtained at least 40% in the qualifying examination.
2. Applicants with Commerce Stream must have studied Mathematics or Economics upto XII.
3. Only one relevant vocational paper (Commerce based) would be considered for which the cut-off will be 5% higher than the cut-off declared for the course.
4. For students with Science Stream also, the cut-off will be 5% higher than the cut-off declared for the course.

Eligibility Criteria for B.Com.(Hons.)

Eligibility

1. Candidates should have obtained at least 45% in the qualifying examination.
2. Candidates with Science and Commerce background should have studied Mathematics as an elective subject in Class XII.
3. For students with Science background, the cut-off will be 5% higher than the cut-off declared for the course.
