1. **B.Com(Hons.)**

- i. Candidate must have studied Mathematics as a subject in Class-XII with a minimum score of 50%.

- iii. The cut-off percentage for admission of Non-Commerce students will be 5% more than the stated cut-off percentage in each list for B.Com(Hons).

1. **B.A. (Programme)**

- i. In the calculation of best 04 subjects, only One Vocational and at least one Language are to be considered.
- ii. The marks of Candidates coming from Science, Commerce and other streams shall be reduced by 5%.
- iii. In the first cut off list OBC candidates will be given a relaxation of 5% from the General Category cut off marks with the provision of extending the relaxation to the maximum of 10% so as to ensure that all OBC seats are filled.

Justification: The OBC candidates who have secured marks more than or equal to the general category cut off marks will be treated as general category candidates and will not be admitted against the seat reserved for the OBC category.

- iv. Candidates seeking admission to the course with Music as a subject shall give a trial to the concerned teacher.
- v. Candidates who opt for Music and Sanskrit shall be given a relaxation of 5% in the aggregate cut off.

1. **B.A. (Hons) Applied Psychology**

- i. All applicants with Psychology and English as Subjects in Class 12th will be preferred.

Justification: Knowledge of these would facilitate a better grasp of the subject.

- ii. One Vocational Subject may be counted among the best four.

B.A.(Hons) Hindi

- i. Required marks in Class XII in main subject –Hindi Literature must be 55%

Justification: This will facilitate better learning

- ii. Relaxation for girls is 3% in aggregate marks.

Justification: To encourage girls students to opt for the subject.
