Dear Sir

I am forwarding to you the additional eligibility criteria together with the justifications as decided by the various departments and the Admission Committee:

B.A. (Programme): It was decided that, like in previous years, no vocational subjects will be counted towards determining the aggregate for the cut-off as students with vocational subjects tended to have inflated marks and little academic vigour. Also these students have many professional courses open to them.

It was also decided that the following academic subjects, too will not be counted towards determining the aggregate for the cut-off for the reasons cited above:

B.A. (Honours) English : Admission will be on the basis of the CATE Score.

B.A. (Honours) Hindi: Students must have passed Hindi as a compulsory or elective subject in Class XII. Students having studied Elective Hindi will be given preference. They should also have cleared English in Class XII or have cleared English and Sanskrit in Std. X. Vocational subjects and academic subjects as listed above will not be counted in determining the aggregate for the cut-off.

✓ **B.A. (Honours) Political Science:** Eligibility will be determined on the basis of marks in the aggregate and marks in Political Science. The cut-off for Science and Commerce students (who have not studied Political Science) will be 5% higher. Students should also have cleared English in Std. XII or Std.X. Vocational subjects and academic subjects as listed above will not be counted in determining the aggregate for the cut-off.

✓ **B.A. (Honours) History:** Eligibility will be determined on the basis of marks in the aggregate and marks in History. The cut-off for Science and Commerce students (who have not studied History) will be 5% higher. Vocational subjects and academic subjects as listed above will not be counted in determining the aggregate for the cut-off.

✓ **B.A. (Honours) Sanskrit :** Students must have studied Sanskrit in either Std. XII or Std. X.

✓ **B.Com (Honours) :** Students must have studied English, Accountancy, Economics, Business Studies and Mathematics. For those who have not studied Accountancy, Economics and Business Studies, the cut-off will go up by 2% for each subject not studied.

✓ **B.Com :** Students must have studied English, Accountancy, Economics, Business Studies and Mathematics. For students who have not studied Accountancy, Economics, Business Studies and Mathematics, the cut off will go up by 2% for each subject not studied.
