### Additional Eligibility Criteria for Admission

#### B. Com. (Hons.)

- Category-1 - With Commerce and Maths  
Category-2- - Others with Maths (3% more than Category-1)

#### B. A. (Hons.) Economics

- Category-1 - With Economics and Maths  
Category-2- - Others with Maths (2% more than Category-1)

#### NOTES:

1. For admission in all the Hons. Courses, vocational subjects will not be considered as part of best of four subjects for cut-off and admission.
2. The following academic subjects will not be included in best of four cut-off:
  1. Engineering Drawings
  2. Home Science
  3. Fine Arts
  4. Agriculture
  5. Physical Education
  6. Music
  7. Dance
  8. Bio-technology
  9. Web and Multimedia technology
  10. Fashion Studies

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION IN B.A. (VOCATIONAL STUDIES)**

1. For admission to Vocational Courses, two vocational subjects and two academic subjects will form the basis for admission but the relationship with the main course must be ensured.
2. Academic and Vocational subjects must have the direct relationship with the main courses opted by the candidate.
3. The following academic subjects not related to the Vocational Courses offered by the College, will not be included in best of four cut-off:
  1. Engineering Drawings
  2. Home Science
  3. Fine Arts
  4. Agriculture
  5. Physical Education
  6. Music
  7. Dance
  8. Bio-technology
  9. Web and Multimedia technology
  10. Fashion Studies
4. The students who have studied the same stream of vocational course and are opting for same course in the college will be given a weightage of 5 marks while calculating cut-off. For example, candidates having studies Tourism stream at +2 level will be given 5 marks concession for taking admission in B.A. (Vocational) Tourism only.
