4.	B.A.(Hons.) Political Sc.		2% more than the cut off percentage for students from science and commerce stream	Students from Science and Commerce stream do not have a background of the subject. A better percentage scorer should do well in such subjects new for him/her.

Note:

1. Physical Education will not be considered as subject while calculating the percentage of the best of four subjects.
2. Not more than two Vocational Subjects for B.A. Programme and not more than One Vocational Subject for B.A.(Hons.) or B.Com (Hons.) will be considered while calculating the aggregate percentage to decide the eligibility of the candidates, and 10% of the maximum marks will be deducted from the marks obtained in that subject/s before calculating the aggregate.
