Sub: Additional eligibility criteria for admission to the first year of various courses taught in the college during the Academic session 2011-12.

Sir,

With reference to your letter No. Aca.I/2011-12 dated 19.04.2011 regarding admission process to be followed in the Academic session 2011-12. The college proposes the following additional eligibility criteria for various academic disciplines. The justifications for them are also detailed.

1. Some courses require a minimum competence in English at the qualifying examination.
 - B.A. (Hons) Geography requires that the candidate must have secured at least 60% marks in English at + 2 Level.
 - B. Com & B.Com (Hons) require that the candidate must have studied English at + 2 Level.

These requirements are fixed keeping in mind the facts that the mode of instruction as well as most of the course materials are in English language.

2. Some courses require a minimum competence in Mathematics at the qualifying examination.

- B.A. (Hons) Economics requires that the candidate must have secured at least 70% marks in Mathematics at + 2 Level.
- B.Sc. (Hons) Statistics requires that the candidate must have secured at least 90% marks in Mathematics at + 2 Level.
- B.Com requires that the candidate must have studied Mathematics/Business Mathematics at + 2 Level.
- B.Com (Hons) requires that the candidate must have passed Mathematics at + 2 Level & that Mathematics does not include Business Mathematics.

These requirements are necessary as the courses mentioned have Mathematics as an essential component of their course structure. Further, at the conceptual level these courses incorporate a large component of Mathematical understanding.

3. Some courses require a minimum competence in the specific languages.

- B.A. (Hons) Urdu & B.A. (Hons) Sanskrit requires that the candidate must have studied Urdu and Sanskrit, respectively at least at the class 10th level.
- B.A. Programme – Bengali requires that the candidate must have passed Bengali as a subject at least upto class 8th level. The cut off for admission to this course is declared separately and are usually lower than that for the B.A. Programme.
- B.A. (Hons) Hindi requires that the candidate must have secured at least 60% marks in Hindi at +2 level.

These requirements are necessary as the courses mentioned cannot be studied and taught in any other language. For the student to comprehend the reading materials and lectures, these requirements are essential.

4. Some courses differentiate the cut offs according to the stream of the qualifying exam that the candidate comes from (e.g. Science, Humanities & Commerce) as also whether they have studied a specific subject at the +2 level. The courses which did so for the year 2010-11 are mentioned below as examples:

B.A.[Hons.] Geography 1st year	WITH GEOGRAPHY: 84 % & above marks in agg. [with one Language + three best Elective Subjects] with 80 % & above marks in Geography.
	WITHOUT GEOGRAPHY: a) SCIENCE STREAM: 87 % & above marks in agg.[One Language + three best Elective Subjects] b) HUMANITIES & COMMERCE STREAM: 87 % & above marks in agg.[One Language + three best Elective Subjects]
B.A.[Hons.] History 1st year	HUMANITIES STREAM -With History - 79 % & above marks in agg.[One Language + three best Elective Subjects] OR Without History- 81 % & above marks in agg.[One Language + three best Elective Subjects]
	SCIENCE STREAM - 84 % & above marks in agg.[One Language + three best Elective Subjects]
	COMMERCE STREAM - 87 % & above marks in agg.[One Language + three best Elective Subjects]

B.A.[Hons.] Economics Ist year	A). Commerce Stream : 94.5 % & above marks in agg. [One Language + three best Elective Subjects]
	B). Science Stream: 92.5 % & above marks in agg. [One Language + three best Elective Subjects]
	C). Humanities Stream : 90.5 % & above marks in agg. [One Language + three best Subjects]
B.A.[Hon.] Pol. Science Ist Year	84 % & above marks in agg.[One Language + three best Elective Subjects] with 75 % & above marks in Political Science. OR 89 % & above marks in agg.[One Language + three best Elective Subjects] without Political Science.
B.Com. Ist year	92 % & above marks in agg. with one language plus best three subjects out of the following commerce subjects :- Accountancy, Business Studies / Commerce / Management, Economics and Mathematics / Business Mathematics. Note : i) For any other subject, a deduction of 4% for each subject from the percentage of marks in aggregate will be made.
B.Com.[Hons.] Ist year	94 % & above marks in agg. with one language and the best three subjects out of the following four Commerce subjects : Accountancy, Business Studies / Commerce / Management, Economics and Mathematics Note: i) For any other subject, a deduction of 4% for each subject from the percentage of marks in the aggregate will be made.

These differentiations are made to give equal opportunities to students with different academic backgrounds. This enriches the class and helps in multi disciplinary mingling. All this is also a result of longstanding experiences of these departments.

5. In case of admission to courses other than B.A. (Hons.) Mathematics, B.Sc. (Hons) and B.Sc. Physical/Life/Applied Science, the subjects Home Science/ Engineering Drawing /Fine Arts / Painting/ Physical Education/ Music/ Dance/ Agriculture/ Entrepreneurship and other vocational subjects such as Secretarial Practice, Insurance, Marketing etc. shall be considered as one of the subjects for the calculation of aggregate percentage. However, a deduction of 5% in the aggregate will be made in such cases. It may be noted that only one of these subjects will be considered for the purpose of calculating the aggregate percentage.

For admissions to B.A.(programme) and B.Com. a maximum of three vocational subjects can be considered for the purpose of calculating the aggregate percentage. However, for subjects such as Home

Science/ Engineering Drawing /Fine Arts / Painting/ Physical Education/ Music/ Dance/ Agriculture/ Entrepreneurship and other vocational subjects like Secretarial Practice, Insurance, Marketing etc. a deduction of 5% in the aggregate will be made.

This is done based on longstanding experience and practice at the college level and also to level the field for candidates coming from academic and vocational streams.

6. The college proposes to relax the additional eligibility criteria for OBC candidates by a maximum of 10% points wherever applicable.
