

Philosophy

Admissions to B.A. Honours in Philosophy will be done on the basis of merit as per the Categories drawn up by the Department of Philosophy, Hindu College:

Category-A	One Language + Three Humanities/Social Science Subjects Language; Hindi Core, English Core, English Elective, and Other Languages Academic Subjects: English Elective, Philosophy, Mathematics, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Fine Arts, Sociology, Psychology.
Category-B	One Language + Three Science/Commerce Stream Subjects. Academic Subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Biotechnology, Psychology, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Economics, Business Studies and Accountancy.
Category-C	One Language + any Three Subjects from the academic stream.

Category A would be the privileged Category as students with Humanities/Social Science background fair well in Philosophy. There would be a difference of 3% between Category A and Category B, while Category C students would be required to have 5% higher marks than Category A students.

History

Admissions shall be done strictly on merit under the following categories:

Category-A	Candidates with History and One Language and Two Other Social Sciences Subjects.
Category-B	Candidates with One Language and Three Social Science Subjects.
Category-C	Candidates with One Language and Three Science/Commerce Stream Subjects.
Category-D	Candidates with One Language and Any Three Subjects

NOTE:- Over many years the Department has noted that candidates with social science subjects do not acquire as many marks as the candidates with science/commerce streams. Therefore due weightage is given to the candidates with social science subjects rather than to the science/commerce subjects. The difference of percentage between category A & B will be of two percent i.e. category B will be kept higher by 2%. Category C will be higher by 6 % while the last category D would be higher by 8%. This is same as last year i.e. 2010-2011.

Sociology

Category-A	One Language + Sociology + any two elective subjects (3% less than Category - B)
Category-B	One Language + any Three elective subjects (3% more than Category - A)

Justification- The department feels that students who have studied sociology in school should be given weightage.

- The College has facility for instruction only in English. Proficiency in spoken and written English is a must.

Hindi

Category-A	For Art Stream:- 73% and above in best four subjects with 75% and above in Hindi
Category-B	For Science/Commerce Stream:- 78% and above in best four subjects with 75% and above in Hindi

Sanskrit

Admission to B. A. (Hons) Sanskrit, is done in two categories. **Category-A** consists of those students who have studied Sanskrit up to class XII and **Category-B** consists of those students who have studied Sanskrit up to class X only. Several colleges of Delhi University follow the same criteria. Those students who are interested in studying Sanskrit and many students want to secure high percentage in competitive exams opt for Sanskrit as a subject. Generally, commerce and science streams students come in category 'B'. These students who have studied Sanskrit up to X only have basic knowledge of Sanskrit grammar so that they can easily cope with the Hons. syllabus.

Commerce

1.	Minimum 60% marks in English and Maths <u>respectively</u> for all categories specified in the enclosed admission policy for the year 2011-12.
2.	Introduction of minimum 95% marks in Accountancy for category - A

Criteria No. 1 as stated above has been in practice keeping in mind the necessity to be conversant with English and Maths being fundamental to understanding of the various papers of the honours course.

Criteria No. 2 as stated above has been introduced this year after analyzing the data available for the past year. The no. of students who sought admission to the course meeting our eligibility criteria were more than 1100 (Eleven Hundred). Since Hindu College has only one section, the no. of students that we can admit is limited. Therefore we need to impose the said rider this time.

Admission Policy for B.Com. (Hons.), Hindu College for the Year 2011-2012

1. The candidate must have studied and secured a minimum of 60% marks in English and Mathematics to become eligible for admission to this course.
2. The cut-off percentage will be expressed as X% and above in all the lists thereby keeping open the previous lists also.

The students will be divided in 3 categories detailed below.

Category A: For students who have studied the following subjects:

1. English – Core, Functional, Elective
2. Maths - Mathematics, Advanced Mathematics, Business Maths (as allowed by the University)
3. Commerce/Business Studies
4. Accountancy, also known as Book Keeping
5. Economics

For the above students the best four will be determined on the basis of any one language (MIL), and any three of the remaining subjects (2,3,4,5) listed above subject to a minimum of 95% marks in Accountancy.

Category B: For students who have studied the following subjects:

1. English
2. Maths
3. Physics
4. Chemistry
5. Biology

For the above students the best four will be determined on the basis of any one language (MIL) and any three of the remaining subjects (2,3,4,5) listed above. A differential of 2.5% will be observed vis-a-vis category A

Category C: For students who have studied English and Mathematics with three academic subjects.

For the above students the best four will be determined on the basis of any one language (MIL), and any three of the remaining academic subjects, excluding:

1. Physical Education
2. Music
3. Dance
4. Home Science
5. Engineering Drawing
6. Fine Arts
7. Agriculture

A differential of 3.5% will be observed vis-a-vis category A
