With reference to your notification no. Aca.I/2011-12 dated 19th April, 2011, regarding updation of the information bulletin 2011 – 2012 for admission to the under graduate courses, the following changes may please made in our College column.

Course	Name of the College	Add Subject Requirement	Justification
B.Com (Hons.)	Lakshmibai College	- 60% marks in Maths & Economics. - 70% marks in Accounts & Business Studies	A study of these subjects is necessary for a certain level of understanding of the syllabus.
B.Com	”	- Must have passed Maths & Economics in Class XII. - At least 60% marks in Business Studies & Accountancy each.	As Business studies and Accountancy are the basics of Commerce, so students should be well-versed with these subjects. Also, as the new syllabus contains a good portion of Economics, so students should have studied Economics and Maths at Senior Secondary level.

Economics (Hons.)	”	- 60% marks in Mathematics.	Knowledge of this subject is necessary for studying the course.
History (Hons.)	”	- 5% extra for student's with Commerce and Science background.	It is felt that Science and Commerce are more factual and objective and students tend to secure a higher percentage than students from humanities at the senior secondary level. The additional 5% eligibility criteria is meant to be an attempt to provide a level playing field to all.
Political Science (Hons.)	”	- 5% extra for student's with Commerce and Science background.	It is felt that Science and Commerce are more factual and objective and students tend to secure a higher percentage than students from humanities at the senior secondary level. The additional 5% eligibility criteria is meant to be an attempt to provide a level playing field to all.

Hindi (Hons.)	..	- 2% more marks in Hindi (Core) and 2% less in Hindi (Elective).	As Elective Hindi in school requires a higher level of understanding students score less in class XII in it than students doing Hindi Core.
English (Hons.)	..	- 10% more marks in English (Core) and 10% less in English (Elective). Note: Dance, Drawing, Painting and Music are not to be taken into account as the student's easily secure high percentage of marks in such subjects without having requisite English languages skills. - Cut off for Science and Commerce students is stipulated higher.	A difference of ten percent in English Elective and English Core is hereby stipulated on the ground that the former is a literature course and therefore, of a higher level, whereas latter being merely a language improvement course resumes lower status. As Science and Commerce being factual subjects with practicals, students easily secure high percentage of marks - though they lack requisite communication skills in English.
B.A (Prog.)		- To opt for B.D.P. or Maths, Maths upto XII class is required.	Necessary for the proper understanding of the course.
