## SANSKRIT (H)

The candidates should have studied Sanskrit at least up to class X as it is not a subject/language which can be studied without any background.

## B.COM (H)

1. Candidates must have studied Mathematics upto class XII.
2. Best of four subjects will include one language and any three subjects out of Accountancy, Business Studies, Mathematics, Economics, Computer Science and Finance.

## B.COM. (PROGRAMME)

1. Candidates must have studied Mathematics upto class X.
2. Best of four subjects will include one language and any three subjects out of Accountancy, Business Studies, Mathematics, Economics, Computer Science and Finance.

## MATHEMATICS (H)

1. For best four subjects mathematics has to be included.
2. Candidates should have studied Mathematics upto class XII.

## B. A. (PROGRAMME)

1. A relaxation of not more than 10% will be given under ECA category for admission to B.A. (Prog) as merit is being compromised.
2. There should be different cut offs for students who have passed under vocational category, as these subjects are not on offer.
3. To opt for computer discipline, students should have studied one of the following:
  - Information Practice
  - Economics
  - Mathematics
  - Computers
4. All students wishing to study 'Punjabi' and studied Punjabi upto VIII class will meet the teacher-in-charge.

## B.SC. PHYSICAL SCIENCE WITH COMPUTERS

The cut off should be based on Physics, Computers and Mathematics instead of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) as basic knowledge of computers is required for pursuing this course.

## B. A. (H) ECONOMICS

Mathematics to be included in best four subjects as the subjects in this course require a minimum knowledge of Mathematics studied in senior secondary level and further that inclusion of Mathematics would ensure that no other supplementary rider is added to eligibility requirement.

## POLITICAL SCIENCE (H)

**Category I:** Students who have studied Political Science in class XII will be given preference over non Political Science students in terms of aggregate percentage. Subject marks in Political Science will be additional eligibility criteria.

**Category II:** Students who have not studied Political Science in class XII will be required to have a higher percentage of marks in aggregate for eligibility since they do not already have a foundation in the subject but at the same time it will be our endeavor to provide an opportunity to non Political Science students to pursue higher studies in Political Science.

## PUNJABI

The students who want to opt Punjabi as a subject in B.A. (Programme) and have studied Punjabi upto VIII class are eligible.

## ENGLISH

1. Relaxation of one percent in overall aggregate and English Core can be given to those who have studied English as an elective subject at plus two (12<sup>th</sup> class) level of the CBSE Board or any other recognized/equivalent board.

**Justification:** Students with elective English to be given relaxation as stated above because (a) it shows they have prior interest in the subject and an aptitude for the same, having chosen English literature as a subject (b) it prepares them better for the specialized honours course as they have in comparison with others who have studied only 'Core English', have studied literature.
