Kindly refer Notification No. Aca.I/2011-12 dated 19th April, 2011 regarding undergraduate students admission process to be following in the academic session 2011-12.

Ram Lal Anand College (Evening) has decided the following 'additional eligibility criteria':-

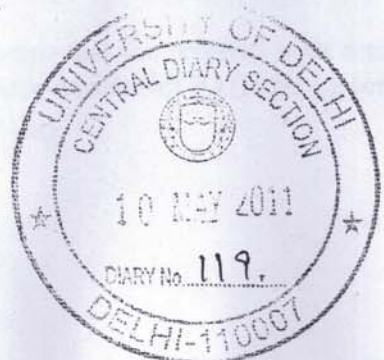
1. Girl students from general category shall be given 3% concession in aggregate for all the courses.

Justification: Girl students are generally hesitant to take admission in the evening college. To encourage greater proportion of admission of girl students in the college, this concession has been passed by the Staff Council. It has been observed that the presence of girl students in the college has a sobering effect on the behaviour of the boys.

2. **B.Com (Hons.)** : i) Students must have passed mathematics in class XII;
ii) Calculation of best four : one language (English/Hindi); and Minimum two papers out of academic subjects in Commerce viz. a) Accountancy; b) Business Studies; and c) Economics.
iii) In case the above subjects do not fulfil the criteria of best four, then one paper in Information Practice may be counted.

Justification: Since Mathematics is compulsory paper in B.Com(Hons.) and Accountancy, Economics, Business Studies are the academic papers in Commerce and Computer / Informatics is also a compulsory paper, all the above form the eligibility criteria.

3. **B.Com Course :** i) Students must have passed Mathematics in Class X.
ii) Calculation of best four :-
a) one language - English/Hindi
b) Minimum of 2 papers form the following academic subjects of commerce stream:-
(1) Accountancy; 2) Business Studies; 3) Economics.
- iii) In case four subjects are not covered as mentioned above, any one of the following may be considered :-
- a) Accounting and Auditing;
 - b) Marketing & Salesmanship
 - c) Banking
 - d) IT Application
 - e) Life Insurance
 - f) General Insurance

Justification : All the papers mentioned under ii) a) and b) are compulsory in B.Com Course and those mentioned under iii) are commerce related vocational papas. In any circumstance, the student must have passed in all the papers that are added to the best four considered.

4. **BA(Hons.) English:** The minimum requirement in English Core is 65% marks; English Elective: 55% marks; and Functional English : 60% marks. There will be on-the-spot writing sample from the candidates who meet the cut-off percentage.

Justification: This is required because certain level of language skill on the part of the aspiring candidates is necessary.

5. **BA(Hons.) Economics:** i) 50% marks in mathematics.

Justification: To ensure minimum necessary level to pursue the course.

- ii) 50% marks in English

Justification: The course is conducted in English language, so the minimum level of ability in written language is necessary.

- iii) The best 4 subjects would be calculated on the basis of one language + 3 other subjects. Subjects included should not have more 30% weightage in practicals.

- iv) Applicants from Commerce stream shall have cut-off of 2% higher marks in overall than applicants from Science and Arts streams.

Justification: Past experience reveals that the students with social science and science background do better than commerce students in BA(Hons.) Economics.

6. **BA(Hons.) Political Science:**

- i) Cut-off marks will be 2% higher for Science / Commerce students than the Arts/Humanities students;
- ii) 50% or above marks in any of the languages (Hindi/English) in 10+2.

Justification: To have a better grip on the Political Science, language skills are necessary because Science and Commerce students score more marks in their respective courses, this would neutralize the disadvantage to social science students.

7. **BA (Hons.) Hindi :**

Minimum 48% marks in Hindi elective; 50% marks in Hindi core.


Justification : This is required because certain level of language skill on the part of the aspiring candidates is necessary.

8. **BA Programme :** only one vocational subject will be taken into account for calculating aggregate.

COMBINATIONS:

- i) **Economics – Math:** Mathematics as an elective subject would be given only to those students who have a minimum of 40% marks in Class XII, in Mathematics.
- ii) **History – OMSP :** Students must have studied History or Business Studies in class XII. One of the following vocational subjects will be taken into account:-
 - a) Secretarial Practice; b) Stenography; c) Typing; and d) Computer-Application / Informatics.
- iii) **Political Science – History :** Students must have studied History or Political Science in Class XII.
- iv) **Economics – IRPM :** Students must have studied Economics in class XII.
