
**Additional Eligibility Criteria**

**B.Com (Hons.)**

1. **For B.Com (Hons) course:** The student must have studied Mathematics and secured at least 50% marks.
2. Student with Commerce Stream: Base Cut- off  
Commerce Stream means:
  - a) At least two subjects from Mathematics, Accountancy, Commerce & Economics.
  - b) One subject from Computer Science, Informatics Practice, Web & Multimedia Technology, Office Secretary Ship, Accounting & Auditing, Marketing & Salesmanship, Purchasing & Storekeeping, and Banking, Financial Market Management..
3. Non-Commerce Stream: Those who do not satisfy the criteria at (2) above.  
Increase of 3 percent in the Base cut-off in order to bring them at par with Commerce stream students.

**B.Com(Prog.)**

1. Commerce Stream: Base Cut- off  
Commerce Stream means:
    - b) At least two subjects from Mathematics, Accountancy, Commerce & Economics.
    - c) One subject from Computer Science, Informatics Practice, Web & Multimedia Technology, Office Secretary Ship, Accounting & Auditing, Marketing & Salesmanship, Purchasing & Storekeeping, and Banking, Financial Market Management..
- Non-Commerce Stream: Those who do not satisfy the criteria at (1) above.  
Increase of 3 percent in the Base cut-off in order to bring them at par with Commerce stream students.



### B.A (Hons.) Geography

1. One Core language + best three elective subjects including Geography :Base Cut - off.

Or

One Core language + three elective academic subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (PCM) or Computer Science: Base Cut-off

2. One Core language + any three elective academic subjects excluding subjects at (1) above: Increase in the base of cut-off by 3%.

The justification is to bring Non Geography/Non PCM or Computer Science students at par with Geography/ PCM or Computer Science students.

### B.A(Hons.) Political Science

1. One Core Language + Political Science and two other elective academic subjects: Base cut-off.
2. One Core language + Best three elective subjects without Political Science: Increase Base Cut-off by 3%


The justification is to bring Non Political Science Students at par with students who have studied Political Science.

### B.A(Programme)

Base Cut-off:

**In B.A. Programme** cut-off percentage shall be calculated on the basis of one Core Language and best three Elective Subjects.

However, one Vocational or other subjects such as Physical Education, Home Science, Agriculture, Music, Dance, Fine Arts, Engineering, Computer Science/Informatics Practices, Environmental Education, Web & Multimedia Technique, Bio-Technology etc. will be considered by increasing the cut-off percentage by **5 per cent** so as to bring them at par with performance in academic subjects
