**ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION
TO DIFFERENT UNDERGRADUATE COURSES**

B.Com. (Hons.)

Category I – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) and Mathematics (in class 12th) and any three of the following subjects:

Accountancy / Book Keeping, Commerce / Business Studies / Business Organisation / Business Management, Economics, Computer, Information Technology and relevant vocational subject.

Base Cut-off

Category II – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) and Mathematics (in class 12th) and any two of the subjects mentioned in Category I.

Base Cut-off + 1%

Category III – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) and Mathematics (in class 12th) and any one of the subject mentioned in Category I.

Base Cut-off + 2%

Category IV – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) and Mathematics (in class 12th) and who has not studied any of the subjects mentioned in Category I.

Base Cut-off + 4%

B.Com. Programme

Category I – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) (in class 12th) and Mathematics (in class 10th) and any four of the following subjects:

Accountancy / Book Keeping, Commerce / Business Studies / Business Organisation / Business Management, Economics, Computer, Information Technology and relevant vocational subject.

Base Cut-off

Category II – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) (in class 12th) and Mathematics (in class 10th) and any three of the subjects mentioned in Category I.

Base Cut-off + 1%

Category III – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) (in class 12th) and Mathematics (in class 10th) and any two of the subjects mentioned in Category I.
Base Cut-off + 2%

Category IV – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) (in class 12th) and Mathematics (in class 10th) and any one of the subjects mentioned in Category I.
Base Cut-off + 3%

Category V – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) (in class 12th) and Mathematics (in class 10th) and who has not studied any of the subjects mentioned in Category I.
Base Cut-off + 5%

Economics (Hons.)

A student must have studied Mathematics (in class 12th) and secured 65% marks in it.
Base Cut-off

English (Hons.)

Admission to B.A. (Hons.) English course will be done through the Combined Aptitude Test for English (CATE), to be held under the aegis of the Department of English, University of Delhi. The College will admit the students from the CATE score list, on the basis of cut-off fixed by the College.

Geography (Hons.)

Category I – Includes a student who has studied Geography (in class 12th).
Base Cut-off

Category II – Includes a student not falling in Category I.
Base Cut-off + 5%

Hindi (Hons.)

Student must have studied Hindi Core/Elective (in class 12th) and secured 50% marks in it.
Base Cut-off

History (Hons.)

Category I – Includes a student who has studied Humanities subjects including History (in class 12th).
Base Cut-off

Category II – Includes a student who has studied Humanities subjects but has not studied History (in class 12th).

Base Cut-off + 2%

Category III – Includes a student who has studied Commerce or Science subjects.

Base Cut-off + 5%

Mathematics (Hons.)

Student must have studied Mathematics (in class 12th) and secured 65% marks in Mathematics.

Base Cut-off

Political Science (Hons.)

Category I – Includes student who has studied Political Science (in class 12th)

Base Cut-off

Category II – Includes students not falling in Category I.

Base Cut-off + 5%

B.A. Programme

One Language (Core) and three best subjects (in class 12th).

Note:

1. The Additional Eligibility Criteria have been fixed by the College Staff Council/Admission Committee under Chief Coordinator Admissions, keeping in mind specific requirements of each course (especially Honours courses). It may be noted that we have been following this practice for the last more than 40 years and we are satisfied with this.
2. The cut-off percentage of marks would be increased by **five (5%) percent** over and above the category in which the candidate is eligible, in case the student desires to include the following subjects (**Home Science, Fine Arts, Agriculture, Physical Education, Music, Dance and Fashion Studies**) in the best four subjects for determining his eligibility for admission. As far as vocational subjects are concerned, only subjects relevant to the main academic course shall be considered in the case of Honours courses.
3. Student should have studied one relevant vocation subject for Hons. Courses and two relevant vocational subject for B.Com. and B.A. Programme

Category IV – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) (in class 12th) and Mathematics (in class 10th) and any one of the subjects mentioned in Category I.

Base Cut-off + 3%

Category V – Includes a student who has studied Language (Core) (in class 12th) and Mathematics (in class 10th) and who has not studied any of the subjects mentioned in Category I.

Base Cut-off + 5%

Economics (Hons.)

A student must have studied Mathematics (in class 12th) and secured 65% marks in it.

Base Cut-off

English (Hons.)

Admission to B.A. (Hons.) English course will be done through the Combined Aptitude Test for English (CATE), to be held under the aegis of the Department of English, University of Delhi. The College will admit the students from the CATE score list, on the basis of cut-off fixed by the College.

Geography (Hons.)

Category I – Includes a student who has studied Geography (in class 12th).

Base Cut-off

Category II – Includes a student not falling in Category I.

Base Cut-off + 5%

Hindi (Hons.)

Student must have studied Hindi Core/Elective (in class 12th) and secured 50% marks in it.

Base Cut-off

History (Hons.)

Category I – Includes a student who has studied Humanities subjects including History (in class 12th).
