**Subject: Riders on various courses as applied by S.G.T.B. Khalsa College during admission and their justifications**

Sir/Madam,

Please find enclosed the detailed list of riders as applied by S.G.T.B. Khalsa College during admission to various courses offered by the college. These riders are applied by the college after discussion with the convenor of the concerned Departments. The brief justification as required by the University Notification Aaca.I/2011-12 is as follows

- 1) Since the medium of instruction in the college is English, the students seeking admission to various courses (other than Indian Languages) are required to have workable knowledge of English. For which subjects of sciences require students to have at least 50% while those in Commerce and Humanities stream should have above 60%.
- 2) In case of B.A. English (H), considering the high cut-off that the college usually has, resulting for large applicants, the rider is 80% in English, with no admission offered to students who studied functional English in their XIIth.
- 3) In subjects that have a large amount of Mathematics in their course, a prerequisite of 70% in Maths would be applied as a rider in B. Com (H), B.A. Eco (H) and B.Sc. Maths (H).
- 4) In case of Indian languages like Hindi and Punjabi, to encourage students to opt for these courses, a simple rider that they have studied the concerned subject in Xth and VIIIth respectively, has been added.

Also, relaxation as determined by the admission committee will be given to applicants belonging to Sikh Community and linguistic minority. Such students will have to study Punjabi as a subject in courses where Punjabi is offered.

I request these details maybe reflected in the University Information Bulletin for the benefit of the applicants.
